

Deadline to submit is March 23, 2018. Award winner will be announced on April 6, 2018.

- Must be a certified teacher
- Must have attended the March 3, 2018 Out in Space, Down to Earth STEM Educator Conference
- Project execution must fall within the 2018 calendar year (Spring & Fall)
- Project must cover at least 3 TEKS
- Grant winner must present at the 2019 Out in Space Down to Earth Educator Conference:
   Presentation can include project findings, video, photos, lessons learned, execution outline, etc.
- A complete application (must have school principal or lead administrator signature in support of this project.) to include:
  - o A one-page educator resume that includes any past awards or recognitions
  - Project Budget and any other funding being received for the current project being proposed
  - Copy of Texas Teacher Certification


